

## **Gatwick Airport**

Also known as London Gatwick, [Gatwick Airport](#) is London's second-largest international airport and the second-busiest (after Heathrow) in the UK.

Gatwick boasts the world's busiest single-use runway taking a maximum of fifty-five aircraft movements per hour.

The airport has two terminals – North and South – that cover 98,000 square metres and 160,000 square metres respectively.

Similarly to Heathrow, the land that Gatwick Airport stands on was first developed as an aerodrome in the late 1920s. The first approved commercial flights from the site took off in 1933. The airport's first terminal 'The Beehive' was built in 1935. Then major development work took place during the 1950s.

Although it has two runways the airport operates as a single-runway airport.

The airport is a hub for [British Airways](#) and BA and [Easyjet](#) are Gatwick's dominant resident airlines.

The air traffic using Gatwick represents the three main airline business models of full-service, low/no frills and charter. This makes it unique among London's airports.
